

General Rules for this show

- Only German Shepherd Dogs are allowed to enter the show.
- Dogs must be registered with a WUSV Registry (AKC, etc).
- Dogs 12 months and older must be registered with USA when owned by a resident of the US.
- Dogs must be FREE of all signs of illness.
- Dogs cannot be barred from progeny registration.
- The owner must be a USA member when they reside in the US.
- Any person that has been barred from exhibiting dogs shall not own a dog entered in the show.
- *No surgically altered dogs.
- *The age of the dog for determining the proper class shall be its age on the first day of the show.
- *Proof of current vaccinations is requested of all dogs entered.
- *All dogs shown in classes 12 months of age or older must be registered with USA Breed Registry Program. The cost is \$70.00 payable to USA. A registration application can be completed on the day of the show. If your papers are in process with the USA office then you must provide a letter confirming that USA registration is in process. Dogs over 12 months must have a certified pedigree.
- *All dogs over 12 months of age will be tested for gun sureness.
- *Dogs entered in the working dog classes **WILL** be required to show proof of working titles.
- *There will be no intersex or interclass competition.
- *Dogs over 3 1/2 years of age must have been surveyed in order to be eligible for a "V" rating.
- *Dogs must be shown on a fur-saver type collar **Only**. No leather and/or nylon collars are permitted.
- *All dogs **MUST** be tattooed or microchipped before entry into the conformation show. **It is the responsibility of the dog owner to bring a working chip reader to the show.**
- *Only those dogs entered in the show will be allowed on the show ground.
- *USA Membership application may be completed on the day of the show.

- *Handlers of dogs in each class must have in their possession the original or notarized copy of the original pedigree for the dog. For dogs in the working class they must be able to provide the scorebook, hip certification (if vying for a "V") and when breed surveyed respective forms.
- *The adult class is designed to accommodate dogs over 24 months of age that do not yet have a working title.
- *Approved working titles are: SchH, IPO, HGH, and DPO titles.
- *Show entries must be paid for all dogs entered in the show even if the dog is not shown. **There will be NO refunds.**
- *All entries received by October 13, 2007 will be considered on time. Entries received after that date will be considered late and a \$25.00 late fee will be charged.
- *Late entries will **NOT** be included in the catalog.
- *Day of show entries will be accepted. Late entries for the breed survey will be accepted up to one hour before the start time of the survey and show entries will be accepted up to one half hour before the start time of the show. Please **DO NOT** wait until the last minute as this will delay the start of the show.

Dental Notation Procedure

As set forth in "Schutzhund USA", a summary of paragraph 4.3 of the SV conformation show rules provides: "Conformation show ratings are not influenced by teeth which are partially or completely missing due to external influence. It is required to have proof of the existence of a previously healthy and strong dentition with a complete scissor bite. The following proof is acceptable:

1. Entry by a Koermeister or conformation judge in the corresponding section of the scorebook, showing proof of complete dentition as soon as dog receives permanent teeth.
2. Koerschein showing proof of dental status at time of first survey.
3. Entry by the USA office in the pedigree.

Some scorebooks at this time do not contain a dental notation section. The required form, which may be inserted in your dog's scorebook, can be obtained at the show registration desk.

Paperwork checklist

Use this checklist to make sure you have all of the required paperwork for the show. You are required to **submit copies of all necessary paperwork with your entry. Don't forget to bring your originals to the show!**

Youth, Young, and Adult:

1. **Proof of dog's USA registration:** either original pedigree, notarized copy of original pedigree, or letter of pending registration from USA.
2. **Proof of current membership in USA:** either a copy of USA membership card or mailing label off of Schutzhund USA magazine. If you are a resident of the United States of America and own a dog (12 mos. or older) entered in the show.

Working Classes:

1. **Proof of dog's USA registration:** either original pedigree, notarized copy of original pedigree, or letter of pending registration from USA.
2. **Proof of Breed Survey Report:** either original or notarized copy of original. If dog has already been breed surveyed **or** is over 3 ½ yrs old vying for the rating of excellent.
3. **Proof of hip certification:** either the "a" stamp on the pedigree or proof of OFA certification. If dog entered is vying for the rating of excellent.
4. **USA recognized scorebook:** with record of the dog earning at least a SchH1, IPI or an HGH.
5. **Proof of current membership in USA:** either a copy of USA membership card or mailing label off of Schutzhund USA magazine. If you are a resident of the United States of America and own a dog (12 mos. or older) entered in the show.

Breed Survey

1. **Proof of dog's USA registration:** either original pedigree, notarized copy of original pedigree, or letter of pending registration from USA.
2. **Proof of Breed Survey Report:** either original or notarized copy of original, if the dog is entered for any type of survey other than a first-time survey.
3. **Proof of hip certification:** either the "a" stamp on the pedigree or proof of OFA certification.
4. **USA recognized scorebook:** with record of the dog earning at least a SchH1, IPI or an HGH.
5. **Proof of passing of an AD** recorded in your scorebook.
6. **Proof of at least a "G" show rating:** at least one show card from a USA recognized conformation event. The minimum rating accepted is that of "G (Good).
7. **Proof of current membership in USA:** either a copy of USA membership card or mailing label off of Schutzhund USA magazine. If you are a resident of the United States of America and own a dog (12 mos. or older) entered in the show.
